Dear Friends,

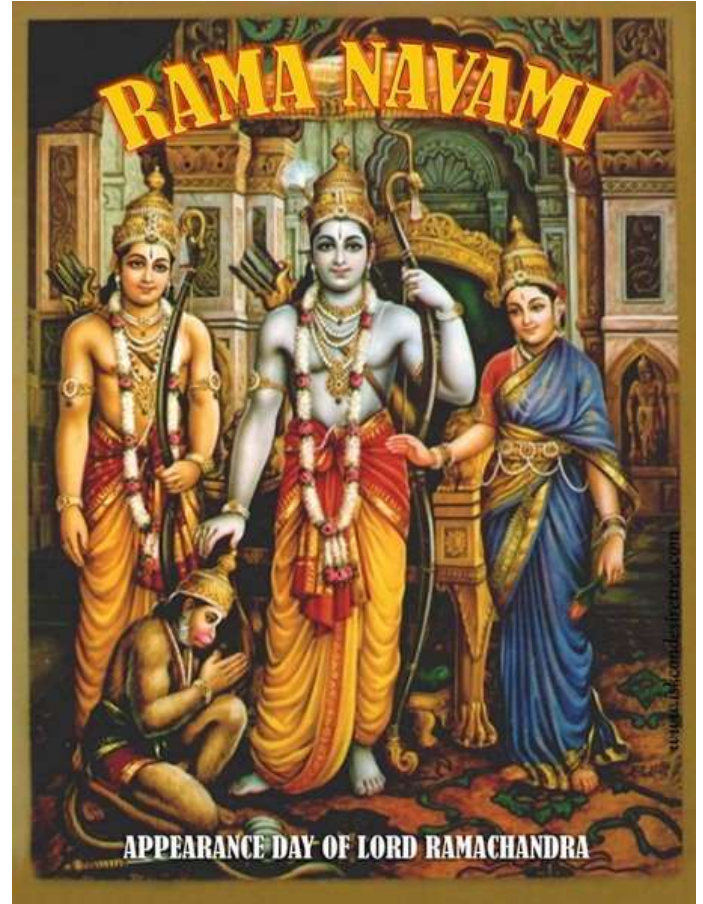
