## Hawaii Welcomes Tamohara Prabhu as Hawaii's New GBC

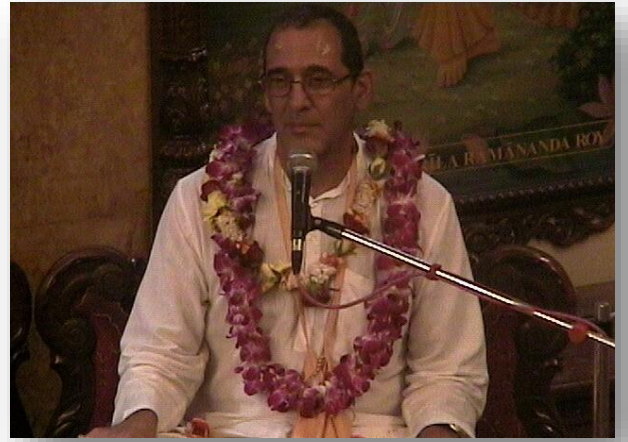
Tamohara Prabhu is the new GBC for Hawaii. He is visiting Honolulu from July 8 through 15. Tamohara Dasa has a doctorate in educational psychology and has been a faculty member and administrator in several graduate schools and universities, including dean of the Illinois School of Professional Psychology.

Tamohara Dasa and wife Mantrini Devi Dasi first saw the Hare Krishna devotees chanting at a rock festival, after which they were inspired to purchase Bhagavad-gita As It Is, the Radha Krishna Temple album, Krishna posters and incense at their local bookstore. They joined the ISKCON Chicago temple in 1972 and were initiated by Srila Prabhupada nine months later.

Tamohara Dasa has been involved in ISKCON leadership for many years. In addition to services of temple president, BBT manager and director of two gurukulas, he served as the director of the ISKCON Child Protection Office,

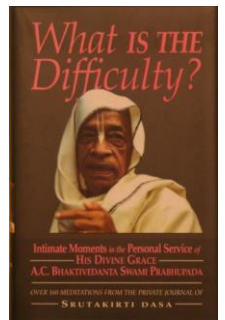

Srutakirti Prabhu is arriving in Hawaii July 30 and will be staying for a long visit, perhaps several months. Srutakirti became Prabhupada's personal servant in August 1972. His service was to be by Prabhupada's side twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. He traveled with Prabhupada for 2 1/2 years, and around the world five times. He travels the world giving talks on his remembrances of Srila Prabhupada and has published many of his memories in his book "What is the Difficulty?"
