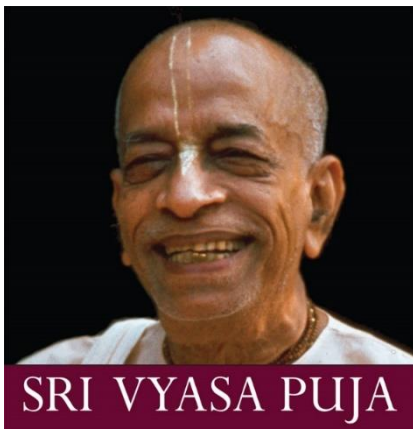

Sep 9, 2015

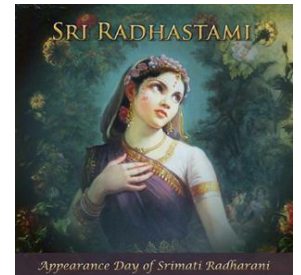

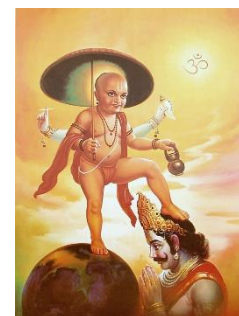

\* Trayodasi (Break Ekadasi fast 06:20 - 10:22 Hawaii Time)

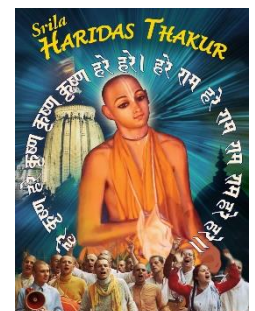
\* Sri Vamana Dvadasi: Appearance of Lord Vamanadeva (Fasting was done yesterday)
